Message from the Board Chair and CEO

Greetings, Community Partners, Donors, and Friends!

Notwithstanding the many challenges and changing landscape the past couple of years, I am happy to report that Alder Health Services continues to be successful in providing high quality health and wellness services to LGBTQ+communities across the region. Our success speaks to the strength, vision, and commitment of our incredible Alder staff and Leadership Team.



After serving as the Agency's Treasurer and Finance Committee Chair since early 2019, I was elected as Board Chair in June 2021. On a personal note, I appreciate the tremendous support from fellow Board members and the ongoing guidance they provide. I am immensely proud of this esteemed group of volunteers. My tenure as Board Chair has been professionally and personally rewarding in so many ways.

While not exhaustive, I would like to highlight just a few of our accomplishments and the initiatives we have embarked upon over the past year. A major area of focus was to create and implement a new three-year Strategic Plan to serve as the road-map for how we will achieve our mission by focusing on four strategic priorities for the agency. Senior leadership was a partner with the Board to share a common vision in the development of the Plan's goals and objectives. We also began the intensive task of working toward achieving Basic Standards for Excellence through the Pennsylvania Association of Nonprofit Organizations (PANO), signifying that our organization practices the highest level of ethics, accountability, and transparency. Finally, we established a Diversity, Equity & Inclusion (DEI) Ad-Hoc Committee of the Board to ensure that Alder Health incorporates policies and practices of inclusion that become part of the fabric of all that we do. Members of the Committee include representatives from a diverse cross-section of community leaders who have experience in this space.

The Board and CEO also appreciates the importance of prioritizing that our staff is working at a prominent level of performance and accountability in a positive and supportive work environment. We are fortunate to employ an experienced, capable, and committed staff led by our widely respected President & CEO, Rosemary Browne. In June 2021, the CEO and her Leadership Team assessed the agency's organizational structure and department level functions to identify the skills, talents and interests of our staff that went were best suited for the positions they currently held. The CEO has already begun to see the positive impact of this approach and a level of greater satisfaction by staff in their roles as well as in overall job performance. We also found ways to better engage our staff in understanding the operations of the agency overall and how each staff member, program and service plays an integral part in our collective success.



Carmen supervises all day to day for our mental health patients, therapists and psychiatrists.






Our Services

Alder Health Services continues to focus on a fully-integrated and holistic system of care. This allows greater access, communication and physical proximity among behavioral health and primary care providers and the health center support team. The benefit of this health center model is to afford our medical patients and behavioral health clients the optimum in collaborative care, treatment, and referrals for specialty services.

Below you will find just a fraction of all that Alder Health Services can provide for those struggling with AIDS/HIV and in the LGBTQ+ community.



Behavioral Health



Case Management

Therapy services are offered in-person and through telehealth.

Individual, Couples, and Family Therapy is provided by our Masters-level therapists who are trained and experienced in working with stress, trauma, anxiety, intimacy issues, depression, gender identity, sexuality, and much more. They are also skilled in working with those infected and affected by HIV/AIDS.

Compassionate medical case management services are provided to individuals living with HIV/AIDS in South Central Pennsylvania.

Our case managers help clients understand and access the many resources available to them including rental/housing assistance, prescription medication, utilities assistance, food, clothing and other basic life necessities. Medical case management is available to HIV+ individuals residing in the counties of Adams, Cumberland, Dauphin, Franklin, Juniata, Lancaster, Lebanon, Mifflin, Perry and York.



Primary Care



HIV/STI Testing

Our Primary Care Clinic provides a stigma-free environment with a wide range of services that promote health equity.

Primary Care services are fully integrated with Behavioral Health, Case Management and HIV/STI testing and treatment services in order to provide a holistic approach to patient care. As part of our comprehensive approach, transgender health services are also available

Screenings and treatment services are available for Syphilis, Chlamydia, Gonorrhea, and HIV.

These services work to provide individuals with the knowledge, skills and resources they need to reduce their risk of HIV and STI infection, and to protect the health of safety of themselves and others.

Our Services Continued





While many of our wellness services were temporarily suspended due to COVID restrictions, we continued to plan and develop programming that could begin once restrictions were lifted.

During our time of limited person-to-person interaction we completed our structure and program design with a special focus on a gender affirming clothing market and the Gibson-Copeland Food Pantry that provides nutritious foods and basic toiletry items. Many of our wellness activities, such as Yoga, took place virtually and we look forward to returning to in-person programs in 2022!
